Odo Instruction
 10.0 Traffic light.
Turn right into Moema Street.



10.2 Stop.
Turn left into Vilakazi Street.
The only street in the world where two Nobel Prize winners (both alive) lived - Nelson Mandela and Archbishop Desmond Tutu!



10.5 On left is Mandela's house.
Mandela Family Museum.
Stop and enter the museum if you would like to.



10.6 Proceed down street.
Tutu's home is the grey-walled house on the corner.



10.8 Stop.
Turn right into Khumalo Street.

11.0 Traffic light.
Turn right into Klipspruitvalley Road.

13.3 Traffic light.
Turn left into Moroka Nancefield Road.
 Proceed 50m and stop at Shisanyama (meat seller), Knorrox Butchery on left, disembark.
Depart Shisanyama (with quarts and a snack) and proceed up Moroka Nancefield road. Cross over railway bridge. Maponya Mall construction on right. Maponya started as a lowly milk seller, then started a small General Dealer in Soweto. Today his mall will cost more than R800 million to build!



14.2 Traffic light.
Turn left into Mbankisa Street.

14.5 **Stop. Turn left.**
